



Train the Trainer

(16 – 32 Hours Based on Training Needs)

Electrical safety training is critical to the safety of anyone involved in maintaining electrical equipment. The e-Hazard Train the Trainer (TTT) program is geared toward organizations with multiple shifts, a large workforce or multiple departments.

The four-day intensive training program prepares qualified trainers to deliver instruction to others within an organization, using materials developed by leading industry experts. The e-Hazard TTT format and all teaching materials have been designed by a professional adult education specialist. The program provides organizations with expert resources, support and the latest information on electrical safety, while maximizing the knowledge and experience of their own personnel.

Course Prerequisites

- Solid background in electrical systems and ability to respond knowledgeably to electrical safety questions
- Strong knowledge of applicable electrical safety standards, i.e., NFPA, OSHA, NEC and NESC

Registered students receive a homework assignment prior to the course. The homework includes a review of best practices for instruction and learning methods, and two lessons from the training to prepare for presentation.

What to Expect

The first two days of class are devoted to students attending the latest **Low Voltage Qualified** and **High Voltage Qualified** classes taught by our expert trainers. These courses include up-to-date information about OSHA standards released in April 2014 and NFPA 70E 2015 changes.

Students learn how to teach the classes. We integrate a variety of methods revolving around the student presenting a short sample of the course. This includes:

- Videotaping the student while presenting
- Coaching
- Teacher and peer evaluations of each attendee's instruction

The final day, each student teaches a second lesson, incorporating insights gained through the previous day's training.
